## **Wales-based International Art Prize takes winning works to China**

The Lumen Prize Exhibition - the only prize for digital art that takes its winning works on a global exhibition tour – has travelled to Shanghai for the 3<sup>rd</sup> leg of its global tour with the 50 winning works.

FQ Projects will play host to the Lumen Prize's latest exhibition. It specializes in promoting and developing young contemporary artists. It is located in Huai Hai Fang which is one of the most famous cultural lanes in Shanghai.
